Get Political.

- Vote for politicians who are committed to poverty reduction and to addressing issues of homelessness. Information about how to vote and what candidates are running in your riding can be found at: www.electionsontario.on.ca. Ask candidates what they are doing to address poverty and homelessness. Call, send an email or attend an all candidates meeting.
- Organize a group to meet with your City Councillor, Member of Provincial Parliament or Member of Parliament. Bring them a copy of **The Street Health Report 2007**. Ask them what they are doing to address the recommendations in the Street Health Action Plan.
